

Did You Know

- As a young person you can see a doctor or nurse on your own or with a friend.
- You can be seen by either a male or female member of staff or see one of the nurses.
- The practice is fully accessible for wheelchair access and has a hearing loop but if you feel there are further changes needed please let us know.
- You can ask us about:
- Stopping smoking, healthy eating and weight management, drugs alcohol, sexual health including Chlamydia screening contraception emergency contraception and mental health issues as well as general health issues.
- We can refer you to other services if needed.
- We can perform pregnancy tests and support your pregnancy choices.
- We offer contraception as well as emergency contraception in the surgery.

Prescriptions for contraception are free!

Advice or treatment, make an appointment to come in and see us. You can do this by dropping into the surgery and speaking to reception staff.

When you arrive at the surgery for your appointment, let the receptionist know. You'll then be called into see the doctor or nurse when they are free.

OR

You can phone and ask to speak to the doctor or nurse. If they're busy, you can leave your number and they'll ring you back.
